WOUND CLINIC AND TRAINING CENTER

Due to the need for quality wound care delivery in our region, Saint George Hospital University Medical Center opened its doors to a Wound Clinic and Training Center in February 2012. The center associated itself with a number of international organizations to provide the best in-house training center and one of the very few specialized Wound management facilities in the country and the region.

As a specialized Wound Training Center, our goal is to educate healthcare professionals on delivering proper care for patients with chronic wounds as well as implementing preventive measures to improve the quality of life of our patients.

SESSIONS

The sessions are based on the German Association Initiative Chronic Wounds, (ICW) training concept, which is offered internationally by more than 130 trainers providers and have been attended by approximately 15,000 participants. This training concept consists of 13 courses divided into four different modules covering all relevant topics in order to become an expert in managing and treating chronic wounds as shown in the enclosed modules table.

Incorporated into the curriculum, are 61 hours of theoretical sessions, including workshops, which are combined with 16 hours of hands-on clinical training.

The practical part of the course will also include a five-page case report on a treated patient.

CERTIFICATION

Upon the completion of module four and after passing the written examination, participants become ICW® Wound Experts, certified by TÜV Rheinland.

The certificate is valid for five years. The participation in annual refresher seminars enables the participants to obtain re-certification.
